There were no citizen's concerns.

Linda Troup made a motion to accept the Secretary's minutes as presented. It was seconded by Brian Zettlemoyer. All approved.

Brian Zettlemoyer made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. It was seconded Daryl Beiler. All approved.

There was no Engineer's report.

Under Operator's report: Daryl Beiler made a motion to approve Smith Service and Maintenance proposal for repairs at Mill Park pump station. It was seconded by Linda Troup. All approved. It was reported that someone was in Vicksburg pump station today. We will need to change locks. Todd Oberdorf said we need to get Buffalo Crossroads pump station serviced. Linda Troup made a motion to get 3 proposals. It was seconded by Daryl Beiler. All approved.

Linda Troup made a motion to file lien on Robert Kitchen's property. It was seconded by Brian Zettlemoyer. All approved. Daryl Beiler made a motion to send delinquent letters to Zachary Johnson, Cherry and Richard Sloan and Sandra Smith. It was seconded by Brian Zettlemoyer. All approved.

Under old business: We are waiting for Township to approve and finalize ordinance for lateral inspections.

Under new business: Linda Troup made a motion to accept the agreement with LAJSA contingent on one sentence that needs added. It was seconded by Brian Zettlemoyer. All approved. It will be presented at June meeting for signatures. Eddie Koebke presented insurance premium. Linda Troup made a motion to approve premium and to have Lena Baumer sign. It was seconded by Daryl Beiler. All approved. Eddie is also going to check on more cyber coverage for us. Daryl Beiler made a motion for Brian Zettlemoyer to fill out new truck registration. It was seconded by Linda Troup. All approved. Brian Zettlemoyer abstained from voting. Eric Scheimrieff will need 2 separate hook-ups for sub-division. He will need a sewer permit for a new hook-up.
